1. What are cookies?

Cookies are files or pieces of information sent by a website through a server and stored in the user's browser. This allows the website to store and retrieve information about a user's browsing habits or their device and, depending on the information they contain and how the device is used, they may be used to recognize the user.

2. What types of cookies does this website use?

The following information will help you better understand and assess our cookies policy: According to the length of time they remain active:

• Session cookies: These are cookies, managed by us or by third parties, designed to collect and store data while the user accesses a website. They are typically used to store information that is only necessary to provide the requested service on a single occasion (e.g., a list of purchased products). Their duration is 20 minutes.

According to their purpose:

- **Technical cookies:** These are cookies, managed by us or by third parties, that allow the user to navigate through a website, platform, or application and use the different options or services available, such as controlling data traffic and communication, identifying the session, accessing restricted areas, remembering items in a shopping cart, completing a purchase order, registering or participating in an event, using security elements during browsing, storing content for video or audio broadcasting, or sharing content via social networks.
- Analytical cookies: These are cookies, managed by us or by third parties, that allow the responsible party to track and analyze the behavior of users on the websites to which they are linked. The information collected is used to measure website, app, or platform activity and to create browsing profiles of users to improve the service based on the analysis of usage data.
- **Geolocation cookies:** These are cookies, managed by us or by third parties, used to determine the location of a user when they request a service. This cookie is anonymous and is used, for example, to offer appropriate information depending on the country in which the user is located.
- Customization cookies: These are cookies, managed by us or by third parties, that allow the user to access the service with some predefined general characteristics based on a series of criteria on the user's device, such as language, browser type used to access the service, regional settings from where the service is accessed, etc.
- Advertising cookies: These are cookies, managed by us or by third parties, that allow for the most efficient management of advertising spaces on the website, adapting the content of the ad to the content of the requested service or the use made of our website.

4. What is the purpose of processing cookies linked to personal data?
